CUNCORD SINGERS

The Concord Singers started to sing together in early 1966. They are a young amateur group, whose backgrounds include teaching, secretarial work, banking, insurance, journalism, travel and the Civil Service. They give frequent concerts in London and other parts of England and have won prizes at eisteddfodau. In 1967 they went to Switzerland, where they were awarded a first prize in the Montreux International Choral Festival.

Their repertory consists mainly of unaccompanied works in many languages, ranging from mediaeval to modern. They have taken a particular interest in the music of Benjamin Britten, who last year kindly consented to become their Patron.
