Concert presented by the London Concord Singers

In October 1982 the London Concord Singers visited Holland as guests of the North Holland Chamber Choir. We are therefore delighted that we, in our turn, are able to welcome them to London.

The North Holland Chamber Choir was founded in 1970. It is a mixed ensemble of 36 voices. Although the choir includes a few professional musicians and some members have received vocal training, it is mainly composed of enthusiastic music lovers who simply enjoy singing good music. The members, varying in age and occupation, come from all over the province of North Holland to rehearse each week in the village of Schoorl, close to the historic town of Alkmaar. One of them is an expatriate Englishman, now working for the EEC in Holland, who indeed used to sing with the London Concord Singers.

In addition to regular concerts in North Holland and other parts of the Netherlands, the choir performs on radio and television. It has participated in international festivals in The Hague and Llangollen and has visited Bulgaria, Denmark

and West Germany.

The repertory, as tonight's programme illustrates, spans more then four centuries and is primarily 'a cappella'. In 1982 the choir made a well-received record of music in two sharply contrasting styles, including the rarely-recorded *Liebesliederwalzer* of Brahms.

The conductor, Klaas Venneker, received his degrees in piano and school music from the Conservatory of Amsterdam. For ten years he taught at the Conservatory of Utrecht but terminated his professorship there in 1978 in order to devote more time to conducting. In addition to school music teaching and directing the North Holland Chamber Choir, Mr Venneker also directs several other choirs and opera companies in North Holland.
