PRS ANNOUNCES AWARDS FOR CHORAL ENTERPRISE

Since its inception in 1985 the scheme of Awards for Choral Enterprise, founded by the Performing Right Society in association with the National Federation of Music Societies, has encouraged and helped over 30 choirs and choral societies showing enterprise in the performance of contemporary music.

The administration of the scheme is carried out by the NFMS and all the applications for this year's Awards were considered by a joint committee from both organisations. Applicants were judged on their past, present and future plans concerning the inclusion of 20th century and/or contemporary music in their programmes.
