### **LONDON CONCORD SINGERS**

London Concord Singers are an award-winning chamber choir of about thirty mixed voices, based in central London, with a broadranging repertoire. The choir was established in 1966 by the conductor, Malcolm Cottle and he has remained the Musical Director.

The choir has now been affiliated to the City Lit for a number of years. It gives three main concerts a year in central London. Most performances are a cappella, but there are also performances of larger works with orchestra.

The programmes are varied, ranging from sixteenth century sacred pieces to premieres of new secular works, and we aim to feature rarely performed pieces as well as the more familiar choral repertoire.

#### **LONDON CONCORD SINGERS**

London Concord Singers have given a number of world, UK and London premieres of works by composers such as John Rutter, Andrzej Panufnik, Richard Rodney Bennett, John McCabe, Kenneth Leighton and Michael Ball, as well as pieces specially written for the choir.

The choir has also given performances of major contemporary pieces such as Alfred Schnittke's Choral Concerto and Malcolm Williamson's Requiem for a Tribe Brother. In its 30 year history the choir has performed all of the unaccompanied choral music of Francis Poulenc.

In 1995 the choir won an Award for Choral Enterprise from the Performing Right Society (PRS) and has regularly received these awards in the past. In 1977 the choir won the Performing Right Society's Jubilee Award.
