THE LONDON CONCORD SINGERS

A chamber choir of about thirty mixed voices, the London Concord Singers was established in 1966 by their Conductor and Musical Director, Malcolm Cottle. They have also been affiliated to the City Lit for a number of years. Their repertoire is for the most part a capella, but they also perform larger works with orchestra. They have won a number of awards ranging from the Performing Right Society's Jubilee Award in 1977 to its Award for Choral Enterprise in 1995.

Programmes vary between sacred and secular, from the 16th to 20th centuries and often include works written specially for them. Over the past 30 years they have performed all of the unaccompanied choral music of Poulenc.
