The London Concord Singers were founded 31 years ago by their conductor Malcolm Cottle as a chamber choir of some 25 voices (although they are augmented occasionally for larger works such as the Rachmaninov).

They sing music from the 16th century to the present day, mostly a capella, but occasionally with orchestra. They have won many awards at home and overseas, most notably the Jubilee Award from the Performing Right Society and subsequently several Choral Enterprize awards from the same organisation.
