





## Parry's Songs of Farewell

London Concord Singers' first live concert since December 2019 sees them returning to Hubert Parry's moving, late masterpiece, *Songs of Farewell*, written during the turmoil of the First World War when a number of Parry's pupils at the Royal College of Music were being killed in action. Parry's choice of texts is thought to reflect a yearning to escape the violence of a world at war and to find peace in the heavenly realm. This was a work that Parry was never able to hear complete.

The choir also performs a group of well-loved motets by Bruckner, *Locus Iste*, *Os Justi* and *Christus Factus est*, and William Byrd's great masterpiece *Mass for Five Voices*, written for use in domestic chapels maintained, often at great personal risk, by recusant Catholics.
